Question Verse Application

How to Lead a QVA Study

(Option: Open with Prayer)

1. **Ask the question you've designed** (7-15 minutes)
 - ◆ Keep asking it and let people answer it without judging their answer as good or bad.
 - ◆ Call on the ones who don't speak.
 - ◆ You may need to remind people not to use Bible verses to answer the question, but rather just give their viewpoint.
2. **Turn to the passage and read it.** (7-15 minutes)
 - ◆ Ask, "What do we see?" "What else?"
3. **Ask, "So what?" or "Now what?"** (7-15 minutes)
 - ◆ Ask, "What do we do with this truth?"
 - ◆ Goal: Design on one application everyone can work on.
4. **Pray together** (3-10 minutes)
 - ◆ Either
 - ◆ 1) One person prays for the whole group, or
 - 2) Say, "Let's pray about the lesson. I'll close if _____ will open us.
Anyone can pray in between if they would like."

How to Design QVA Questions

1. Begin with a Bible verse or passage (A Truth)
2. Make up a question that is answered by the verse or passage.
3. Try it out for yourself and ask, "How will they probably answer it?"
4. Ask, "What's the better question?"
5. Repeat steps #3 and #4.
6. Finally give up and pick one question to begin with (it probably won't matter that much).
